Nicely textured with pear and citrus fruit and a touch of spice	Time to have a fresh look at Soave. This is from prime vineyards planted on volcanic soils in the classico zone. Fragrant, supple, with a nice mix of ripe orchard fruit, with an almond twist on the finish.	Barrel fermented Viura and Garnacha Blanca. Complex aromas combining floral characters with preserved lemon, truffle and smoky notes. Nutty, creamy, peachy flavours with a citrus lift on the finish.
